- all (100%) students in Year 3 and Year 5 achieve and/or exceed National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Writing, Reading and Numeracy in 2019 NAPLAN Testing.
- >80% of students achieve C or higher in English and Numeracy assessment.

OR

Provide quality and researched student support learning resources/programs in Writing, Reading and Numeracy for those who are not on track to attain the NMS or are likely to achieve less than C standard, through:


- providing focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- providing Reading Link – daily, one-to-one reading opportunities
- providing online intervention resources

Our initiatives include

- Employing additional teacher aide hours to assist with intervention programs to support students identified as not reaching NMS.
- Developing a shared understanding of 'data literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching.
- Providing quality in-service processes that will ensure best practice in all classrooms, specifically in the areas of Literacy and Numeracy.
- Employing differentiation strategies that will provide opportunity for students to extend their learning.
